

DAY 1 Monday 30 October 2017 Melbourne – Oman ~ (Meals in Flight)

Welcome to Sisterhood Womens Travel! Meet your fellow travellers at the Melbourne Airport for our flight to Muscat (via Dubai) flying Emirates. Sit back, relax and enjoy the inflight entertainment as we head towards our next adventure.

DAY 2 Tuesday 31 October 2017 Welcome to Oman ~ (D)

We arrive into Muscat the capital of Oman around 10.00am this morning. We'll be greeted and transferred to our accommodation with the afternoon free to make use of the hotel's facilities. Tonight we'll regroup for dinner and enjoy our first night in the UAE.

DAY 2 Wednesday 1 November 2017 Muscat (Sightseeing) ~ (B,L)

Today we'll enjoy a half day city tour of Muscat with lunch at a local restaurant.

Today we'll transfer to Nizwa.

Set by a desert oasis and encircled by the Western Hajar Mountains and sprawling date plantations, Nizwa is one of the Sultanate's oldest cities and it was once an important trade and religious centre. A perfect addition to a stay on the coast in Muscat, this striking region offers historic architecture and breathtaking natural landscapes.

We'll enjoy a city tour including the 17th century Nizwa Fort which was strategically built overlooking the town and today stands as testament to the settlement's importance on an ancient caravan route. From its 30 metre high central tower you can admire city views and the surrounding landscapes. Like many towns and cities throughout Oman, Nizwa has a buzzing souq where you can haggle for silver works, spices and dates or local handicrafts.

DAY 4 Friday 3 November 2017 Nizwa – Abu Dhabi ~ (B)

A morning free before checking out and transferring to the Muscat Airport for our short flight to Abu Dhabi. Upon arrival into Abu Dhabi we'll check into our hotel with time at leisure. Our beautiful accommodation, the Yas Viceroy, oozes luxury and over the next 3 nights we'll be able to explore and make use of the facilities including the hotel's two rooftop pools!
